We are looking for interns to support our research and events activities in the field of international relations and dialogue between Europe and Asia. The focus countries of our organisation include China, Japan, Vietnam, and India. Ideal candidates are current students of International Relations degree programmes or equivalent, who are passionate about the field of International Relations and want to gain hands-on experience working with a dynamic and dedicated team.

The internship will offer a flexible working arrangement, with a combination of in-office and remote work, as well as several projects delegation. The internship period will be agreed with the student, ideally lasting between 3-6 months, depending on the start date of the internship.

Responsibilities

- Assist in research and analysis on international relations and dialogue between Europe and Asia (drafting or research documents, policy analysis and briefings, translation of documents)
- Help organize and plan events and meetings (including delegation of meetings and attendance of events hosted in Brussels and Europe)
- Assist in the production of written (communication) materials and publications
- Provide administrative support to the team
- Assistance in strategic processes of expansion alongside the Management team and members of the board.

- Current student of international relations or adequate experiences
- Strong research and analytical skills
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills in English, German and official languages of our focus countries would be considered as advantage
- Strong organizational skills and attention to detail

- Independent, motivated and capable of working under-pressure in multi-cultural environment.
